Obligation of certification according to the Mexican « LPO » Regulation

LPO: *Ley de los Productos Organicos*

- 📍 No equivalence agreement with the EU
- 📍 Only organic products certified or recertified LPO Mexico can be imported into Mexico
- 📍 You can consult the LPO organic Regulation on the Mexican government website : [Servicio Nacional de Sanidad, Inocuidad y Calidad Agroalimentaria](#)

### CERTISYS® controle & Ecocert Mexico certified according to the LPO Regulation

Special feature of the Mexican certification : Re-certification

- 📍 There is no equivalence agreement between the LPO and other organic regulations. This means that LPO certification is required to export organic products to Mexico.
- 📍 LPO re-certification system : approval of a standard via audit of the site carrying out the last operation of production of the organic product.

## CERTISYS® controle & Ecocert Mexico certified according to the LPO Regulation

- 📍 The annual on-site controle is carried out by a CERTISYS® auditor authorised by LPO
- 📍 The certification is under the responsibility of ECOCERT Mexico accredited by the Mexican authorities

### Labelling

- 📍 The official logo LPO can be used
- 📍 Prohibition to refer to organic farming in case of export without certification according to the LPO Regulation
